PLEASE NOTE:

HEALTH & SAFETY & SAFEGUARDING

All competitions at Northern Area Field Day will be Risk Assessed to ensure the safety of competitors, supporters, and guests. Competitors should be aware of relevant Health & Safety issues and thus follow the instructions of judges and stewards at all times. The completion of a PARENTAL AND MEDICAL CONSENT FORM for all members under the age of 18 is the responsibility of the County Federation. It must be available at the Northern Area final and will be requested when booking in for the competition and purchasing dance tickets.





GENERAL RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY

JUNIOR competitors must be 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2023. **INTERMEDIATE** competitors must be 21 years of age or under on 1st September 2023. **OPEN/SENIOR** competitors must be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2023.

All entrants must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine. County Federation offices are urged to ensure that when a member reaches Northern Area Field Day, their cards are valid and correct in the system. It is recommended membership cards are screenshot on phones or printed, failure to access the website is not a valid excuse for cards not being available.

Fines will be issued to Counties for any members/teams who drop out from a competition with less than 48 hours' notice (this includes not turning up on the day of the competition). £20 fine per individual competition, or £60 fine per team competition.

If members can not attend the Presentation of Awards please ensure that someone is available to collect on your behalf.

2. REPRESENTATION

Counties may enter one competitor per 600 members of part thereof in the Northern Area Final.

Federations entering more than one team must designate them A, B or C. Once an entry has been made, competitors cannot be transferred from one team to another. The proportional representation will be calculated from the Membership Statistics as at 31 August 2023.

NFYFC ruling on representing more than one County/Club in a calendar year or event, is as follows: That where a member represents a Club or County Federation in an Area event, they may not represent a different Club or County Federation in any other event in that same competition year (1st September to 31st August). However, a person who resigns from a Club and takes up membership of another, may represent that new Club or its County Federation as from the date of joining, except that they may not represent more than one Club or County Federation in successive rounds of the same competition which leads to a National Final".

3. AWARDS

All competitions on the day will count towards The Earl of Derby trophy.

Points will be awarded as follows: 1st place = 12 points, 2nd place = 11 points, 3rd place = 10 points, 4th place = 9 points and so on to 12th place = 1 point.

If a county does not enter a particular event, they will be awarded 0 points, however if they enter and are disqualified or fail turn to turn up, they will receive -1 point.

The team scoring the highest overall points will win The Earl of Derby trophy.

The team scoring the highest points in Stockjudging will win The Barclays Bank trophy. Certificates will be awarded to teams placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each event. Individual





members of a team will receive a certificate.

4. TIMETABLE

Competitors may compete in more than one competition where the timetable allows them to do so. The timetable is final and will not be changed to accommodate any individual or team. Any competitor not reporting at the time stated, or being unable to compete when we require, will be eliminated, and therefore awarded (-1) point. The organisers will make every effort to keep competitions running to the times stated however cannot be responsible if due to unforeseen circumstances they are unable to do so.

5. JUDGES/STEWARDS DECISIONS

The judges' decision is final. Written notification of intention to lodge a complaint or to dispute the result must be received half an hour prior to the presentation of awards and should be accompanied by a £10 cash deposit. The £10 deposit shall be returned to the individual complaining in the event that the complaint is sustained. If the complaint is not sustained the fee shall be forfeited. Please note that complaints will ONLY be accepted from a competing member or team captain.

Unacceptable behaviour by competitors or supporters, which adversely affects other competitors, will be penalised.

Abusive behaviour towards Judges and Stewards will, in continual and extreme cases, lead to disqualification.

Members are reminded that in taking part in the competitions, material of a questionable nature will be penalised. Members are to bear in mind that they are within a family audience setting.

- 6. County Durham YFC/Northern Area YFC reserves the right to amend or cancel any of the Rules.
- 7. County Durham YFC/Northern Area YFC will not be responsible for any expenses incurred by competitors nor for arrangements for accommodation.

8. HEALTH & SAFETY & SAFEGUARDING

All competitions at Northern Area Field Day will be Risk Assessed to ensure the safety of competitors, supporters and guests.

Competitors should be aware of relevant Health & Safety issues and thus follow the instructions of judges and stewards at all times.

County Durham YFC will not accept responsibility for any members under the age of 18 who have not produced their Parental Consent Form on the day of the Northern Area Field Day. If the relevant forms are not available at the Northern Area Field Day then, in accordance with the Federation's safeguarding, members will not be allowed to take part.

9. HELPING MEMBERS WITH LEARNING DISABILITIES

County Durham YFC supports NFYFC in their effort to seek the inclusion of the full membership in all its endeavours. Should a member require assistance to compete at Northern Area Field Day due to disability (learning/physical), every effort shall be made to ensure





inclusion of the individual with dignity, respect and confidentiality. County Durham YFC requests prior knowledge of assistance required in order to maximise the benefit to the individual.

10. INSURANCE

The cover provided by the NFYFC Insurance Scheme will apply to all Clubs and members participating in Competitions. Each Club has been supplied with full details, and further

information is readily available from the YFC Insurance Department, NFU Mutual Insurance Society Limited on 0191 212 5710.

Class 9 4x4 Tug of War

ELIGIBILITY

A team shall consist of eight pulling members - 4 female and 4 male. No more than two (2) members of a team may be between the ages of 15 and under 17 years on 1st September 2023 and the remainder of the team MUST be between 17 years and 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2023. Competitors must be under 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2023.

Coaches and Trainers - Only one Coach is permitted with each team during pulling. Only one

Trainer or "Water-Carrier" is permitted with each team. During pulling the Trainer shall take up position well clear of both teams and is not permitted to address any remark to them during actual pulling. Neither the Coach nor Trainer need comply with other rules of eligibility.

PROCEDURE

The 8 members team will be weighed as one and will not exceed 600kg. The competitors will be stamped or marked on a limb in a position easily seen by the Judge, but not easily erased by the rope or competitors clothing.

At weigh-in, all team members must have their boots available for inspection by the judges.

SUBSTITUTION, DRAW AND BYES, and PULLING All as per NFYFC Men's/Ladies competition rules





Classes 10, 11, 12 - Beef Stockjudging

Class 10 - JUNIOR Class 11 - INTERMEDIATE Class 12- SENIOR

ELIGIBILITY

All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on 4 finished beef/store cattle. Animals will be designated A, B, X, Y. All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which must be worn during the period of the competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area. Cards will be supplied to each competitor on which must be marked the order the competitor places the items. Only the tear-off section of the card may be used for making notes. During the competition, no other papers or literature may be used.

TIMING

Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes for inspection and handling of the items and each competitor will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score.





Classes 13, 14, 15 - Lambs Stockjudging

Class 13 - JUNIOR Class 14 - INTERMEDIATE Class 15 - SENIOR

ELIGIBILITY

All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on 4 lambs. Animals will be designated A, B, X, Y. All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which must be worn during the period of the competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area. Cards will be supplied to each competitor on which must be marked the order the competitor places the items. Only the tear-off section of the card may be used for making notes. During the competition, no other papers or literature may be used.

TIMING

Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes for inspection and handling of the items and each competitor will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score.





Classes 16, 17, 18 - Breeding Sheep Stockjudging

Class 16 - JUNIOR
Class 17 - INTERMEDIATE
Class 18 - SENIOR

ELIGIBILITY

All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on 4 breeding sheep. Animals will be designated A, B, X, Y. All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which must be worn during the period of the competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area. Cards will be supplied to each competitor on which must be marked the order the competitor places the items. Only the tear-off section of the card may be used for making notes. During the competition, no other papers or literature may be used.

TIMING

Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes for inspection and handling of the items and each competitor will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score.





Classes 19, 20, 21 - Mystery Judging

Class 19 - JUNIOR Class 20 - INTERMEDIATE Class 21 - SENIOR

ELIGIBILITY

All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine

PROCEDURE

Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on 4 mystery items (to be revealed on the day of the competition final). Items will be designated A, B, X, Y. All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which must be worn during the period of the competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area. Cards will be supplied to each competitor on which must be marked the order the competitor places the items. Only the tear-off section of the card may be used for making notes. During the competition, no other papers or literature may be used.

TIMING

Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes for inspection and handling of the items and each competitor will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score.





Class 22 - ATV Handling

ELIGIBILITY

Any competitor aged 17 - 28 years old on 1st September 2023.

All competitors must have an ATV certificate or driving license and be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC. License/certificate must be shown on the day or competitors will not be allowed to compete. Competitors need to provide their own safety equipment: helmet.

Competitors will be required to produce their current and signed membership card. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Competitor to drive around a course showing safety, skill, and accuracy. Anyone driving in an unsafe manner will be stopped/disqualified by the Steward. Competitor must report at the given time to be allocated a time to compete. Failure to report at the allocated time will result in disqualification.

SCALE OF MARKS

To be judged on accuracy and safety and NOT speed. Penalties will be given for shunting, hitting stakes or bollards.

Skill and safety of maneuvers 50 Speed and accuracy overall 50

TOTAL 100

Penalties will be:

10 points for hitting stakes/bollards5 points for shunting

Time will be taken into consideration in the event of a tie.





Class 23 - Vintage Tractor Handling (16 and over)

ELIGIBILITY

Any competitor aged 16 - 28 years old or under on 1st September 2023.

All competitors must have a tractor or drivers' license and be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current and signed membership card. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Team of 2 - one male and one female. One competitor is required to drive the tractor and trailer around an obstacle course, and the other competitor is to reverse back along the same course. Anyone driving in an unsafe manner will be stopped/disqualified by the Steward. Competitor must report at the given time to be allocated a time to compete. Failure to report at the allocated time will result in disqualification.

SCALE OF MARKS

To be judged on accuracy and safety and NOT speed. Penalties will be given for shunting, hitting stakes or bollards.

Skill and safety of manoeuvres 50 Speed and accuracy overall 50

TOTAL 100

Penalties will be:

10 points for hitting stakes/bollards 5 points for shunting.

Time will be taken into consideration in the event of a tie.





Class 24 - Open Mini Digger Challenge

ELIGIBILITY

Competitors to be between the age of 16 and 28 years of age or under on 1 September 2023 and a full member of a club affiliated to the NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Competitors will be required to operate a mini digger as directed by the judge to complete a task. Note: The mini digger will remain stationary and only the boom arm will be operated by the competitor for the tasks, as instructed by the judge.

TIMING

Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes maximum to complete the task, but competitors should remember that the competition will operate as a time trial.

Class 25 - Open Rope a Trailer Challenge

ELIGIBILITY

Team of 2: 1 male and 1 female. Competitors to be 28 years of age or under on 1 September 2023 and a full member of a club affiliated to the NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Team to safely secure a load on a trailer.

SCALE OF MARKS

To be judged on time, accuracy and safety of load.





Class 26 - Open Sports Day Race (Team of 3 - U28, U21, U17)

ELIGIBILITY

Team of 3: one senior, one intermediate and one junior.

Senior competitors to be 28 years of age or under on 1 September 2023, Intermediate competitors to be 21 years of age or under, and Junior competitors to be 16 years of age or under. All to be full members of a club affiliated to the NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Team to compete in a variety of 'traditional' sports day activities.

SCALE OF MARKS

To be judged on time; quickest is the winner.





Class 27 - Open Pallet Challenge

ELIGIBILITY

Team of 2; one male and one female. Competitors to be 28 years of age or under on 1 September 2023 and a full member of a club affiliated to the NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Each team will be supplied with 2 pallets which they are to dismantle and make into an item which will be revealed on the day. The majority of the wood should be used in the construction. No staining, no painting, NO FINISH allowed. No power/battery tools, chainsaws or nail guns allowed. You must bring your own tools. Nails provided. Safety clothing must be worn – STEEL TOE CAP BOOTS, GLOVES AND GOGGLES (not provided).

Class 28 - Open Sand Shift

ELIGIBILITY

Team of 2 members: 1 Junior who must 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2023 and 1 Senior who must be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2023.

Competitors to be 28 years of age or under on 1 September 2023 and a full member of a club affiliated to the NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Teams to move sand from one location to another specified location using the equipment provided on the day. Competitors must wear suitable eye protection during the competition (not provided).

SCALE OF MARKS

Fastest time wins





Classes 29, 30, 31, 32 - Floral Art

Class 29: JUNIOR: Summer Floral Vase

Class 30: INTERMEDIATE: Summer Hand Tied Bouquet

Class 31: SENIOR: Summer Floral Display

Class 32: MALE: Summer Bouquet

ELIGIBILITY

All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

Competitor to produce a floral exhibit per the allocated theme.

PROCEDURE

Applies to all floral art classes: To be viewed from all sides. Maximum space allowed: 75cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height. Pre-cut and pre-soaked oasis is allowed. No pre-cut flowers allowed. Exhibits to be composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories. All the work of the arranging and assembling of materials must be carried out during the competition. Competitors must wear white coats.

TIME 1 hour with a further 10 minutes to check that arrangements have not been disturbed during clearing up operation.

Class 33 - Eating Challenge

ELIGIBILITY

Team of 2; 1 male and 1 female. Competitors to be 28 years of age or under on 1 September 2023 and a full member of a club affiliated to the NFYFC. Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE Competitors to eat a selection of "unknown" dishes in the fastest time. Competitors must make Northern Area Field Day committee aware of ANY allergies via a signed disclaimer form with confirmation of entry.

SCALE OF MARKS

Number of "dishes" eaten and time taken.





Class 34 - Senior Boat Race

ELIGIBILITY

Team of 6. At least 1 of each sex, competitors must be 28 and under on 1st September 2023. All members of the team must be over 18. All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC. Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Competitors to drink a pint of given drink (some may contain alcohol). After each competitor finishes their pint, they must sit down with the pint glass on their head before the next competitor starts drinking.

Competitors must make Northern Area Field Day committee aware of ANY allergies with confirmation of entry.

TIMING Fastest time wins





Class 35 - Junior Cooking - Floddies

ELIGIBILITY

The competitor must be 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2023. All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Competitors to display 4x Floddies. To be displayed within 30cm x 30cm. A5 recipe card must be displayed within the set area.

SCALE OF MARKS





Class 36 - Intermediate Cooking - Steak Bake

ELIGIBILITY

The competitor must be 21 years of age or under on 1st September 2023. All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Competitors to display a steak bake. To be displayed within 30cm x 30cm. A5 recipe card must be displayed within the set area.

SCALE OF MARKS





<u>Class 37 - Senior Cooking – Set Recipe (Pease pudding and corned beef pie)</u>

ELIGIBILITY

The competitor must be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2023. All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Competitor to produce the set recipe outlined below. To be displayed within 30cm x 30cm.

RECIPE: Pease pudding and corned beef pie

Ingredients

500g boiled King Edward Potatoes
1 small sliced white onion
500g Pease Pudding
1 medium eggs
12.5 g of butter
320 g corned beef

Instructions

Pre-heat oven to 200°C standard or 180°C fan

Mix the pease pudding and eggs together into a fine mixture. Add 2/3 to a dish as a pie base and blind bake for 40 minutes.

Soften the onion on a low heat for 5-8 minutes in butter. Mix with boiled potatoes and corned beef. Add filling to pie base and cover with remaining pease pudding mix. Bake for 40 minutes.

Class 38 - Junior Baking - Maids of Honour

ELIGIBILITY

The competitor must be 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2023. All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE

Competitors to display 4x Maids of Honour. To be displayed within 30cm x 30cm. A5 recipe card must be displayed within the set area.

SCALE OF MARKS





Class 39 - Intermediate Baking - Fadgie Bun

ELIGIBILITY

The competitor must be 21 years of age or under on 1st September 2023. All must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

PROCEDURE
